Study Visa Process for New Zealand





- 1 **Receive an Offer of Place** – Secure admission from a New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) approved institution.
- 2 **Prepare Financial & Academic Documents** – Proof of tuition fees and living expenses required.
- 3 **Submit Student Visa (Fee Paying Student Visa) Application** – Apply online through the New Zealand Immigration website.
- 4 **Health Check & Biometrics Submission** – Required for visa approval.
- 5 **Receive Your Visa Decision & Travel to New Zealand** – Once approved, prepare for your studies.

 **Processing Time:** 4-12 weeks (may vary based on application volume).





Post-Study Work & PR Opportunities

- **Post-Study Work Visa (PSWV)** – Stay and work for **1-3 years** after completing studies.
 - **Skilled Migrant Visa** – Gain eligibility for permanent residency.
 - **PR Pathways** – Work and gain residency through skilled job opportunities.

-  **Part-time Work** – Up to **20 hours per week**.

Estimated Cost of Studying in New Zealand


-  **Tuition Fees:** NZD **20,000 - 40,000** per year (varies by university & course).
-  **Living Expenses:** NZD **15,000 - 20,000** per year.
-  **Health Insurance:** NZD **500 - 1,000** per year.
-  **Miscellaneous Expenses:** NZD **3,000 - 6,000** per year.

FAQs – Study in New Zealand

♦ **Can I work while studying in New Zealand?** Yes, up to 20 hours per week during studies and full-time during vacations. ♦ **How long can I stay after graduation?** You can stay for **up to 3 years** with a post-study work visa. ♦ **Is IELTS required for a New Zealand student visa?** Yes, IELTS or an equivalent test is required. ♦ **Can I apply for PR after studying?** Yes, through the Skilled Migrant Category Visa.
